



Assistant Chief Constable Terri Nicholson was appointed as Deputy Senior National Coordinator for Counter Terrorism in the UK in March 2017.

Terri has 30 years Police Service, with diverse senior leadership and investigative experience gained in CT and Organised Crime across all detective ranks. Her career includes secondments to the National Crime Squad and SOCA, where she led numerous high profile serious and organised crime investigations.

Since 2011, Terri has held senior leadership positions in CT Policing, most recently as Head of Operations at the Met's SO15 Counter Terrorism Command, the largest CT Unit in the UK. Her portfolio included International and domestic CT operations and her teams were responsible for the disruption of numerous attack planning plots in the UK and overseas.

Terri retains a keen interest in Terrorist Finance and Money Laundering, an enduring passion which stems from her early career in banking. She is the National Police Chiefs Council lead for Terrorist Finance. She is a Master of Science (MSc) in Criminal Justice (inc Criminology) awarded by the University of Leicester.

A graduate of the Five Eyes Leadership in Counter Terrorism programme, Terri is the current President of LinCT AA and a member of the Executive Advisory Board.
